ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES: Collect dust using a vacuum cleaner equipped with HEPA filter. Avoid dust formation. Following product recovery, flush area with water. **ELIMINATE** all ignition sources (no smoking, flares, sparks or flames in immediate area). If sweeping of a contaminated area is necessary use a dust suppressant agent which does not react with the product.
