PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS. CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

HAZARDS TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS. For external use on cats only. Individual sensitivities, while rare, may occur after using any pesticide product on cats. Certain medications can interact with pesticides. Do not treat your cat with more than one pesticide product at a time. Overdosing a cat can result in serious illness and even death. As with any product, use caution before using this product on medicated, debilitated, aged, cats with known organ dysfunction, pregnant or nursing cats. If the cat is exhibiting signs of and/or is being treated for skin dermatitis, use caution before applying any topical flea and tick control product.

FIRST AID

If swallowed:	Call a poison control center or a doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If in eyes:	Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call the poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If on skin:	Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO APPLY PRODUCT.** TO PREVENT HARM TO YOU AND THE CAT, READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE. FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS CAREFULLY. Do not use on rabbits or animals other than cats. Do not allow the cat to ingest this product. Do not use on kittens under 8 weeks of age and weighing less than 1.5 lbs. Do not apply more than once every 30 days. Do not overdose cat. Separate the treated cat from all other cats and dogs for 24 hours after treatment has been applied. Remove tubes from packaging. Using one applicator tube, hold the tube with the narrow end pointing up. Snap the applicator tip across the marked line to allow access to the dotted tip. Holding tube away from you and your cat's eyes, snap the applicator tip to open. Invert tube over cat and use open end to part cat's hair. Apply at a spot between the cat's shoulder blades. Squeeze the entire contents of the applicator and direct the solution in one spot and onto the cat's skin. Do not apply more frequently than once every 4 weeks.

Side Effects: Monitor your cat after application. Some cats may experience some temporary skin irritation such as redness, scratching, or other signs of discomfort. Gastrointestinal signs such as vomiting or diarrhea have also been reported. If these or other side effects occur, consult your veterinarian or SafetyCall at 1-844-685-9173.

FREQUENCY OF APPLICATION

This product should be applied once every 30 days. Treatment remains effective, even after bathing, water immersion, or exposure to sunlight. Do not reapply ShieldTec for Cats for 30 days.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

How to Open

1. Remove tubes from packaging.
2. Using one applicator tube, hold the tube with the narrow end pointing up. Holding tube away from you and your cat's eyes, snap the applicator tip to open.

How to Apply

1. Invert tube over cat and use open end to part cat's hair.
2. Apply at a spot between the cat's shoulder blades. Squeeze the entire contents of the applicator and direct the solution in one spot and onto the cat's skin.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep product in its original container. Do not repackage. Store in a cool (below 77°F /25°C) dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Do not refrigerate. Protect from direct sunlight.
